WELCOME TO THE IRON ROAD CUP

Thank you for joining us for a weekend of competitive soccer, sportsmanship, and community. The Iron Road Cup exists to create a safe, positive, and family-friendly environment for all players, coaches, and supporters.

This rulebook outlines the standards every team must follow to participate.

COACH CHECKLIST

Before your first match:

- Submit **final roster**
- Bring player cards or proof of age (digital or printed)
- Check in at Field HQ 30 minutes before kickoff
- Ensure sideline respect & sportsmanship
- Keep team area clean after every match
 - Failure = 1-point deduction in standings
- Respect referees, opponents, staff, and facilities

1. TOURNAMENT GOVERNANCE

1.1 Rules

Tournament follows:

- Texas association standards
- US Club Soccer
- FIFA Laws (youth modifications apply)

Iron Road Cup rules supersede all others where conflicts exist.

1.2 Referee Authority

Referee decisions are **final** and not subject to appeal.

2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION

2.1 Roster Requirements

- All players must be on the official roster before Match 1
- No player may appear on multiple rosters

2.2 Proof of Age

Upload ONE of the following during registration:

- Official ID with photo, OR
- Birth certificate + recent photo
- Players Cards from GotSports from valid Association US CLUB, USYS, or USSSA

2.3 Deadlines

- Players must be registered by Friday 11:59 PM
- Full payment due Friday no wristbands = no participation

2.4 Wristbands

- Distributed **Saturday**, 1 hour before team's first match
- Must be worn for the entire event
- Replacement: \$5 fee

3. PROTESTS

A protest is valid only if:

- 1. Submitted before end of first half
- 2. Filed by the **affected team**
- 3. Submitted at registration desk
- 4. Includes \$100 deposit
 - o Returned if upheld
 - o Forfeited if denied

Ineligible player protest: coach must provide proof immediately.

4. CONDUCT, SAFETY & ZERO TOLERANCE

4.1 Zero Tolerance – Referee Abuse

Applies to players, coaches, parents, and spectators.

Consequences:

- Parent abuse → Yellow card to coach
- Repeat → Red card + match abandonment
- Severe → Removal from facility + future ban
- Physical threats → Immediate expulsion

4.2 Facility Expectations

- No alcohol, smoking, vaping, or pets (unless venue allows)
- Keep sideline area clean
 - Violation = 1-point deduction
- Respect all city property and staff

4.3 Player Safety

- Hydration breaks at 85°F+
- Concussion = immediate removal
- Mercy rule: 8+ goal lead → match may be shortened

4.4 Security

Local police will be onsite.

Tournament is **not liable for individual misconduct**.

5. MATCH RULES

5.1 Player Equipment

- Matching uniforms
- Numbers minimum 6 inches
- No duplicate jersey numbers
- Shin guards required
- No jewelry, metal hair accessories, or hard casts

5.2 Points & Tie Breakers

Points:

- Win = 3 points
- Tie = 1 point
- Loss = 0 points

Tie Breakers:

- 1. Head-to-head
- 2. Goal differential (max +5 per match)
- 3. Goals scored (max 5 per match)
- 4. Fewest goals against
- 5. Penalty kicks

5.3 Referees

- $5v5 / 7v7 / 9v9 \rightarrow$ Single referee
- 11v11 → Three officials
 All decisions are final.

5.4 Discipline

- Two yellows = red card
- Violent red = 1-game suspension or expulsion
- Leaving field prematurely = automatic forfeit

5.5 Forfeits & Reporting

- Late 15 minutes \rightarrow forfeit (1–0)
- Walking off early → automatic forfeit
- Scores posted on LeagueApps

6. MATCH FORMATS

ॐ 5v5 (U6−U7)

- Ball size: 3 (2019) / 4 (2018)
- Two 20-minute halves
- GK allowed

- No headers
- No offsides
- Slide tackles allowed with caution

ॐ 7v7 (U8–U10)

- Ball size: 4
- Two 25-minute halves
- Build-out line in effect
- Keeper may NOT punt/drop-kick
- Offside only between build-out line and goal
- No deliberate headers
- Slide tackles with caution

9v9 (U11–U12)

- Ball size: 4
- Two 25-minute halves
- Offsides: Yes
- 2015: No headers
- 2014: Headers allowed
- PKs allowed
- Slide tackles with caution

11v11 (U13+)

- Ball size: 5
- Two 30-minute halves
- Offsides: Yes
- Headers allowed
- PKs allowed
- Slide tackles with caution
